We consist of a diverse network of friends who volunteer our time to make a difference towards improving the quality of life in developing countries. The name Sahaya is derived from an old Sanskrit word that means "HELP".

Since 1998, we have been partnering closely with several grassroots organizations in India, and assist them with many educational and socio-economic developmental programs that empower the least privileged and most vulnerable sections of the society. This includes schools, vocational training, HIV/AIDS programs, and women self-help groups with micro-finance activities. We also have an orphan sponsorship program through which many Davis residents support a needy child for \$30 per month.

Sahaya International also supports programs in Kenya, Vietnam, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Colombia.
