Introduction:

SEE NGO is a registered, non-governmental organization shared its commitment for the welfare of downtrodden and marginalized women community. It involves their socio-economic sustenance through organizing women SHGs among Dalits, backward community, fishing community and the people living below the poverty line. We are conducting evening tuition centers and livelihood measures for target community, and women empowerment programs etc. Currently, SEE NGO is working in three blocks of Cuddalore District. SEE Trust conducts its several welfare initiatives through collaborating overcome agencies, private institutions and like-minded groups.

1. Neighbourhood Children Parliament:

1.1.1. Formation of Children Parliament:

- We have been formed 17 Neighbourhood children Parliament in 13 villages by regular visit of the children as well as their parents.
- In each children Parliament 20 to 25 members are there.
- The total Members of Female children 209 and Male Children 195.
- The total Neighbourhood Children Parliament members are 404.

- **1.1.3. Library Maintenance:**

- We have been Opened NCP Library 10-10-2010 with 52 books
- And now there are 156 books in the library.
- The total readers 191 from October to till the month of March -2011.

1.1.4. Children 's Garden:

- *Children together started the vegetables garden in order to develop the four important principals:*

1. Caring of the plants [Children are learning to carry each other]
2. Protecting the plants from animals and insects [protecting each other when they go to school and the other places.
3. Sharing the vegetables among the children [Developing the sharing capacity].
4. Reviving of the culture [Following the traditional culture]
 - 26 children were together formed a children Garden in a common place where they have followed the above mentioned four principals.
 - Now they are continuing their third term cultivation of the vegetables. [You may find them in the pictures]

1.1.5. Children's Day Celebration and Cultural Events:

- We used to celebrate the Children's Day celebrations on every year month of November.
- This year also we celebrated the children's Day function on 20th of November .

- Cuddalore municipality Chairman participated as a Chief Guest for this function.
- One thousand 347 children were participated.
- They have exhibited their talents through materials exhibition , Dance, songs and Street play etc.
- We have distributed the prizes according to their talents.
- The main thing of this celebration is we jointly celebrated with 280 orphan children of Cuddalore social Welfare Board.

1.1.6. Medical Camp:

- We have arranged General Check up and Eye Camp for children.
- 182 children were participated and benefited.
- 11 children were found problems in the eye.
- 1.1.2. Net working with other NGOs/ Poets, CDN, SCN, and NCN:
- We have been networking with POETS NGO , CDN [Children Development Network].
- We also have participate in regular meetings and children programs conducted by State Level Children Parliament [SLCP] and National Level Children Parliament [NLCP].

1.2. Special Days Celebrations

1.2.1. World Environmental Day:

- We have been Celebrated the *world Environmental Day* in the month of 5th of June 2010. Nellikuppam Chairman the chief guest who attended the meeting.
- we have got 1500 different plants and trees with the help of ISHA foundation.
- We have also planted 1500 trees at Mulligrampattu

1.2.2. Pongal Celebrations

- All children parliament leaders discussed and celebrated the Pongal celebration [Tamilnadu culture] on 15-01-11.

- 123 children were participated in the function.
- The Youth Parliament Leaders bought things and prepared Pongal together with all the children.

1.3. Children Parliament Training

1.3.1.Children Rights Training

- NCP Members are given training based on the children rights namely
 1. Right to live
 2. Right to Develop
 3. Right to Protect
 4. Right to Participate.
 - They have been trained according to the rights base.

- Now NCP leaders are clearly trained and leading their groups well.
- We also have regular monthly one day orientation program for all the NCP leaders.

- There are 9 different ministers in each parliament namely Prime Minister, Home Minister, Finance Minister, Education Minister, Public Minister , Law and Order Minister, Communication Minister, Health Minister and Environmental minister.

Children Achievements

1. Education

- Through their continuous effort 13 drop out children put in the school to continue their study again in the year 2010-11. 9 Male children and 4 Female children.
- SEE Trust is helping for 11 children for their education whose mother is a bread winner of the family.
- 5 young girls are put in the community college to do their diploma course.
- And our NCP children using their library at least for one hour apart from their study time except during exam time.

2. Child Rights:

- To recognize and identify the children has rights to participate in development work in the village they had opened the NCP Board with the co-operation of the village leaders.

And they also given awareness program like rally , street play and cultural events participating all the members in the village

3. Social Awareness:

- Since the climate is changing and becoming global warming children have decided to plant the trees and avoiding plastic items [when they go for shop they take cloth bag]
- Each child plant a tree during their birth day.

- Giving awareness for polio drop for 0 to 5 years old child.



4. Children Garden

- The four concepts are 1. caring 2 protecting 3. sharing and 4. Review the traditional culture.

Future Plan for Children program 2010-2011

1. Adopting 10 new villages to form new NCP.
2. Forming Youth parliament to support the NCP action.
3. Giving Child Rights training to all the NCP members and Leaders.
4. Strengthening the formed and newly forming NCP.
5. Tree plantation in every child birth and each NCP once in a month.
6. Giving more important for children education specially higher education in village level NCP.
7. Giving them good education by starting Special Coaching Center in their respective place.
8. Starting HOME for the fully orphan children. This year we are adopting 15 orphan children 5 male and 10 female children.
9. To extend the NCP Library by getting many books.
10. Celebrating special days like children's day, World Environmental day, Summer Holidays events, and Pongal celebration etc

- 11 . Giving special education support for orphan and semi orphan children.
- 12 .Encouraging all NCP to make children Garden.
- 13 . To Take all NCP Leaders for the exertion to Chennai and other special areas.
- 14 . Collaborate to work with other Net work NGOs like CDN [Children Development Work] in Cuddalore District for the development of NCP work.
- 15 . Working with SLCP & NLCP [State and National Level Children Parliament]

II. Women Program:

Introduction :

SEE Trust works to improve the socio-economic level of these women by organizing

Udayam Women Federation among widows, destitute women, HIV/AIDS women, Dalits, the fishing community and other groups living in below the poverty line. SEE TRUST creates awareness among women about their vital role and importance in the socio-economic development of society; about their rights for holistic empowerment in socio-economic spheres; about women development programs through training of their Sangams; about women self-help groups, small savings, credit management and women cooperatives, health care programs for women and children.

1. Udayam Women Federation 1&2

- We have organized women federation namely Udayam [which means raising] in the month of March-2010 with 18 members but now there are 93 women. [widows, destitute, HIV / Positive members and unmarried elderly women.]
- In Udayam 1 federation there are 68 women who are widows, destitute , unmarried elderly women and women who are poor.
- We have the other Udayam-2 federation where only HIV positive members are in the federation.

- We will support nearly 75 members for their IGP program.
- Leaders and the members will be given special coaching in order to develop the Udayam Federation.
- To give awareness training on various level for Udayam Federation members to involve in development work in their respective villages.
- To conduct the General Medical camp for Udayam Federation members at Cuddalore.
- To celebrate women's Day celebration in Cuddalore district by Udayam Women federation
- To support UDAYAM women federation member's children education.
